ORDER ISSUED

Plea and Sentencing hearing 8/9/24: Appearing in person: State of Indiana by DPA, Jeremy Brown with victim, AA; Defendant, Steven C. Hollar, with counsel, Anthony Churchward.

Rights read. Defendant sworn. Factual Basis taken and accepted. Defendant pleads guilty to Ct. I, Criminal Confinement, as a Class A Misdemeanor; and Count II, Battery, as a Class B Misdemeanor. On the State's motion, Counts III and IV are dismissed with prejudice.


Victim, AA, reads Victim Impact Statement.

The Court enters Judgment of Conviction as to Counts I and II. PSI waived. Sentencing issued.

Count I, Criminal Confinement, treated as a Class A Misdemeanor pursuant to I.C. 35-50-2-7(c): 360 days Kosciusko County Jail with credit for one (1) actual day served, plus equal good time credit. The remaining time on the sentence is suspended on 358 days of reporting probation. Defendant is ordered to contact the Kosciusko County Probation Department no later than 8/13/24. The Kosciusko County standard terms of probation are incorporated by reference. Defendant is ordered to have no contact with the victim for the remainder of the sentence. No fine assessed. Defendant is ordered to pay court costs no later than 12/31/24. Cash bond ordered to be applied to court costs. Clerk ordered to return any balance of the cash bond to the person who posted same.

Count II, Battery, as a Class B Misdemeanor, concurrent with Count I: 180 days Kosciusko County Jail with credit for one (1) actual day, plus equal good time credit. The remaining time on the sentence is suspended on 178 days of reporting probation. Defendant is ordered to contact Kosciusko County Probation Department no later than 8/13/24. The Kosciusko County standard terms of probation are incorporated by reference. No fine assessed.
